Soprano: Irene Patta, from Parma, Italy, graduated with honors from the Conservatory A. Boito in Parma under the guidance of Soprano Lucetta Bizzi. She performed in many theaters, among which Teatro La Scala in Milan, Teatro Regio in Parma, Teatro Comunale in Bologna, Teatro Pavarotti in Modena, Teatro Giglio in Lucca, Teatro Sociale in Como, Teatro Donizetti in Bergamo. She performed in concerts and recitals in the frame of major international events, with an intense concert activity especially in Italy, Germany and Austria.



Tenor: Alessandro Goldoni, tenor from Bologna, winner of several opera competitions, covered many roles among which 'Alfredo' in *Traviata*, 'Mario Cavaradossi' in *Tosca*, 'Pinkerton' in *Butterfly*. He performed an intense concert activity all over Italy. He collaborated with the Conservatory of Adria for Nino Rota's opera 'I due Timidi' and participated to the 'Gran Galà della Lirica' in Florence in June 2015 with the Florentine Orchestra. In 2014 he collaborated in the show 'Pathos' by Andrea Bocelli with director Plácido Domingo.
